II. NOFA OVERVIEW A NOTE ABOUT NEW APPLICATIONS & RENEWALS

As noted in the Community Development NOFA, FY 2021-2022 is the second year of a two-year contract period for CDBG and ESG awards. **Renewing applicants must submit a renewal application** through City Data Services in order to receive their second year's funding award.

During FY2021-2022, new funds for Public Services from the PLHA program will be available for the first time. These funds are designated for **shelter services, rental assistance, and rapid re-housing**. New applications will be accepted for these uses only.
